

MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEET

ETHYLENE GLYCOL CS-400

SECTION 6 HEALTH HAZARD DATA

EYES: May cause slight transient (temporary) eye irritation

SKIN: Essentially nonirritating to skin. The dermal LD50 has not been determined.

Massive contact with damaged skin or of material sufficiently hot to burn skin may result in absorption of potentially lethal amounts.

INGESTION: Single dose oral toxicity is believed to be moderate. The lethal dose in humans is estimated to be 100ml (3 ounces) for ethylene glycol.

INHALATION: At room temperature, vapors are minimal due to low vapor pressure

SECTION 7 EMERGENCY AND FIRST AID PROCEDURES

Eyes: Flush with water for at least 5 minutes

Skin: Wash with flowing water or shower

Ingestion: INDUCE VOMITING IMMEDIATELY. GET MEDICAL ATTENTION!

Inhalation: Remove to fresh air
